

Specific facilities Provided for Women

The Gujranwala Guru Nanak Khalsa College, Ludhiana gives highest priority on safety & security of staff & students. It also provides facilities like common room and counseling services as it believes supportive, safe and conducive environments are critical to one's growth.

A. Safety & Security: The institute has taken the following safety & security measures

- A Security personnel is appointed on the campus round the clock.



- The campus is set with a number of suggestion boxes intended to collect any suggestions or any complaint from female staff and girl students of the campus concerning any abuse or harassment.



- Constitutional committees like Anti-ragging committee, College Internal Complaint Committee and Anti sexual harassment committee are constituted as per the university guidelines and are functioning successfully.
- Institute has installed CCTV Cameras at different locations such as at the Entrance of the college, Library, Canteen, Student Sitting areas, and administration Office, Parking, all corridors and Computer Centers.



- All corridors and laboratories are equipped with fire extinguishers.



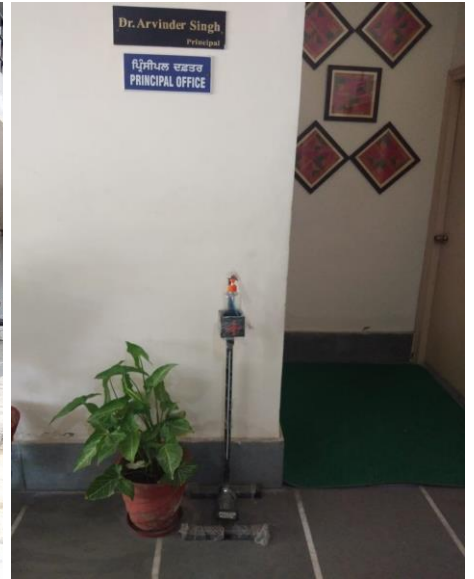
- Do's and Don'ts are displayed in laboratories and the students are briefed on safety precautions.





- To prevent any incidence of accidents, awareness programs on safety & security program are also conducted for girls.





- The college has a campus supervision committee for campus supervision during the working hours.
- The college organizes seminars/special talks/Extension Lectures on a regular basis in order to endorse social values such as gender equality, gender sensitivity and highlights social problems such as women safety, female foeticide, dowry, women's health etc.

A. Counseling:

- The girls are encouraged through counseling to participate in various activities like Annual Social Gathering, NSS, Sports, Youth Festival etc. as per their comfort and interests.
- The College has a well defined student mentoring system for all the programs starting from the first semester. The main objective of mentoring is to help each student in taking right decisions for their academic and personal growth. In addition, mentoring will help to boost student's morale and improve their learning abilities. In mentoring sessions, students discuss their problems regarding academics, general issues and lack of facilities in the college with their respective mentors. Each faculty who mentors the student tries to help the individual regarding their academic and personal issues. A faculty is assigned total of 25 to 30 students to monitor once in a month and record their progress.
- The institute has established Students Counseling Cell for the overall development of the students through interaction.

B. Common Room:

- Common Rooms facility for Girls Students is available.
- A separate sick room is available.



- Girl's common room is available with essential facilities like first aid box, bed, wash basin etc.
